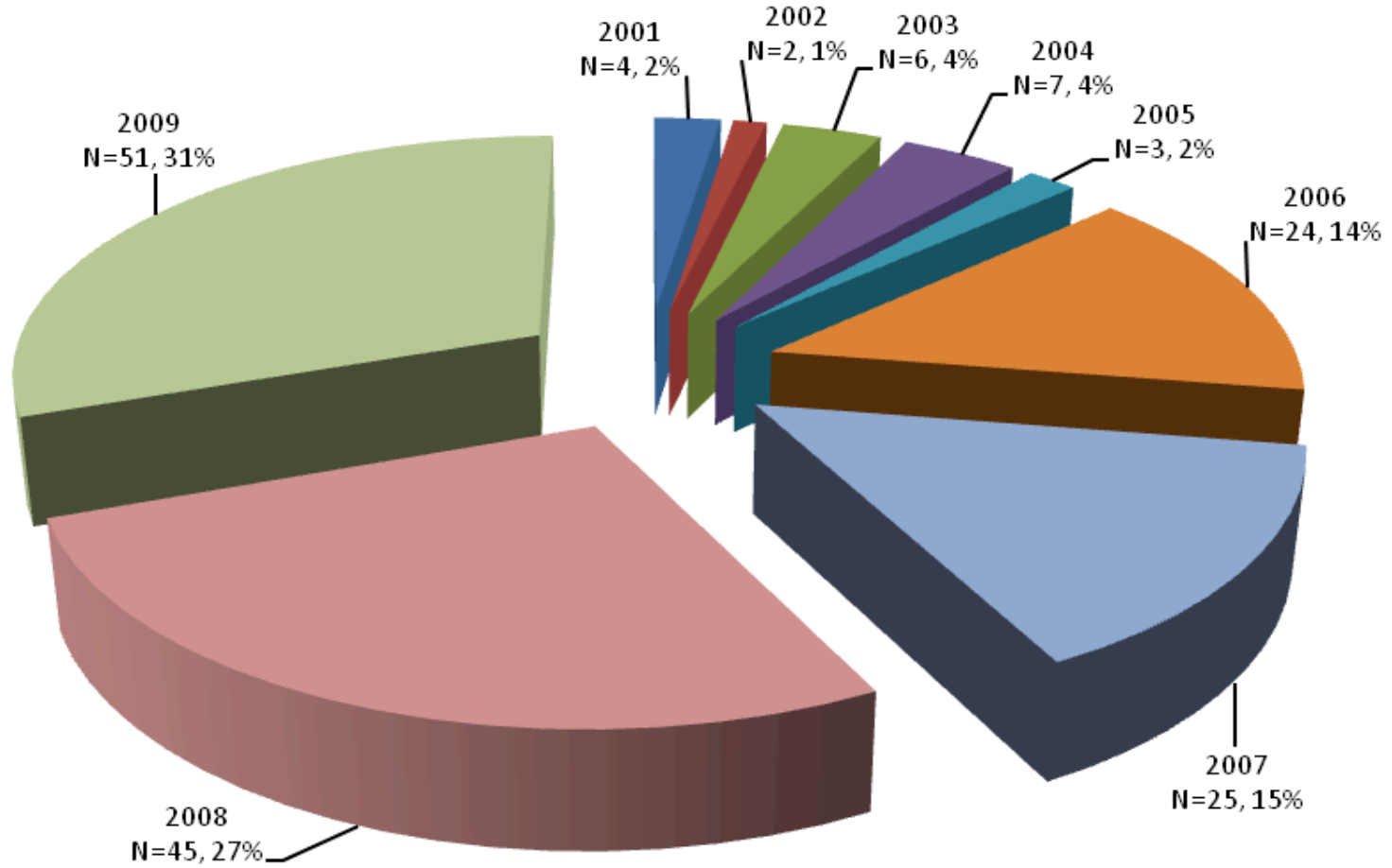

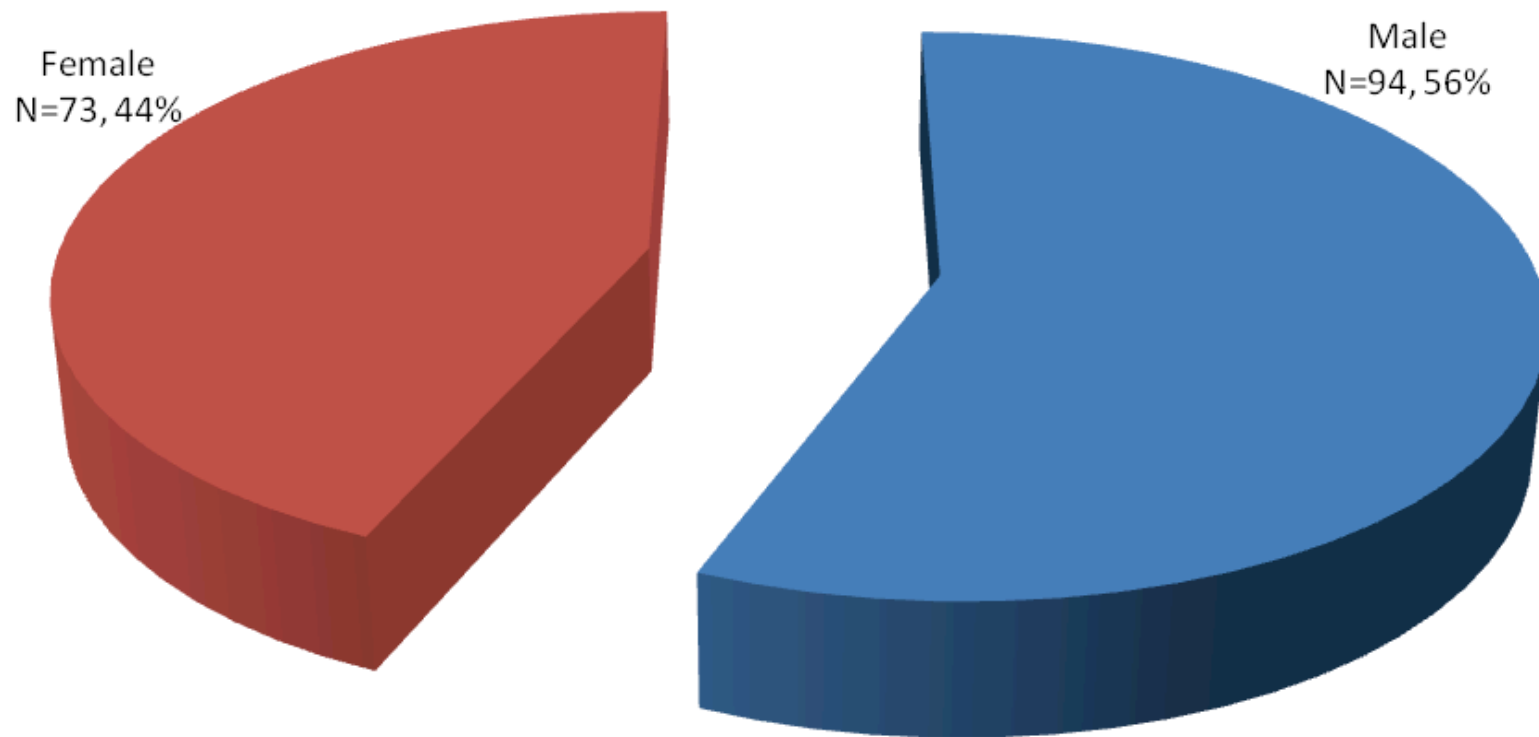

(N = 167)

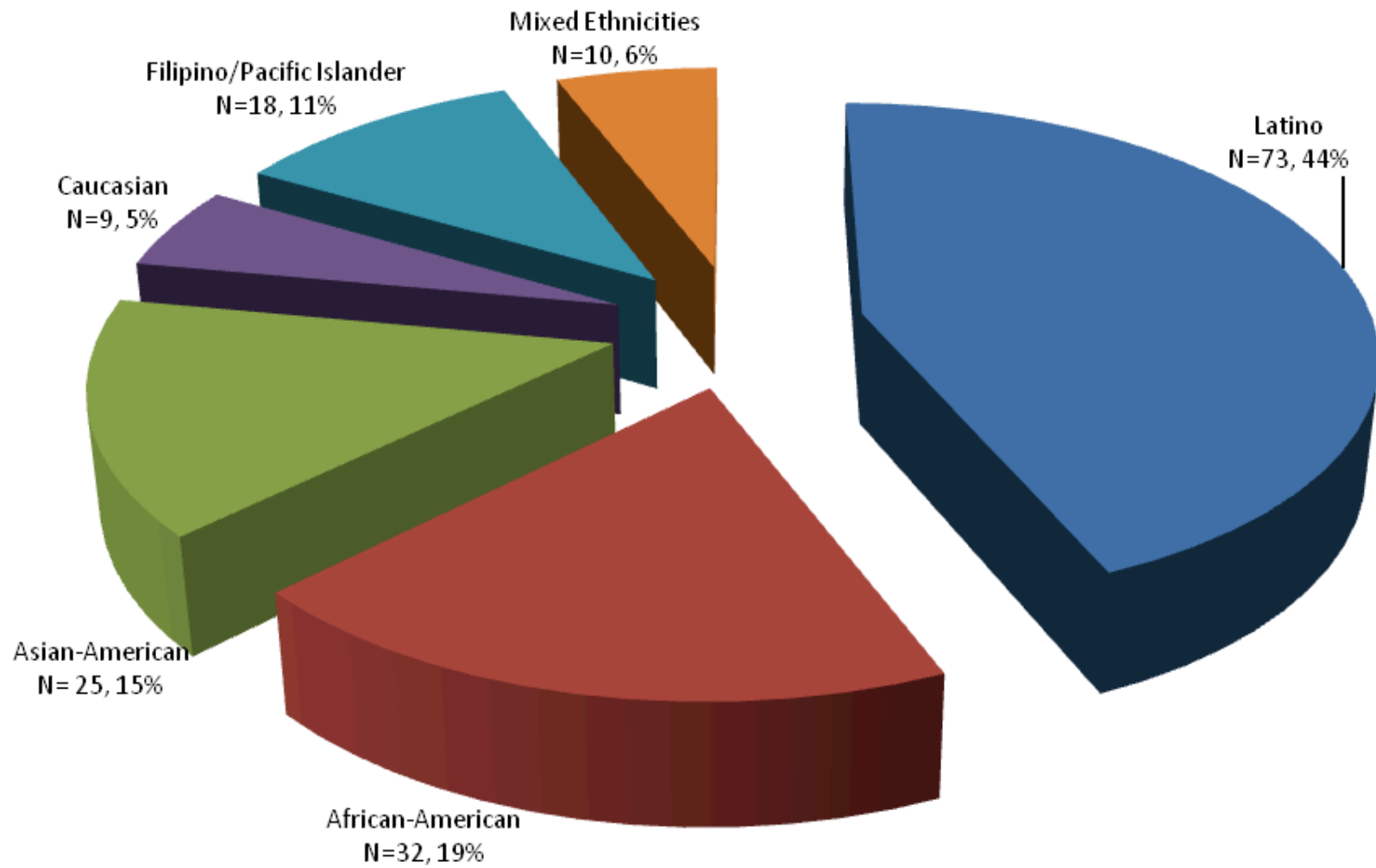

(N = 167)**

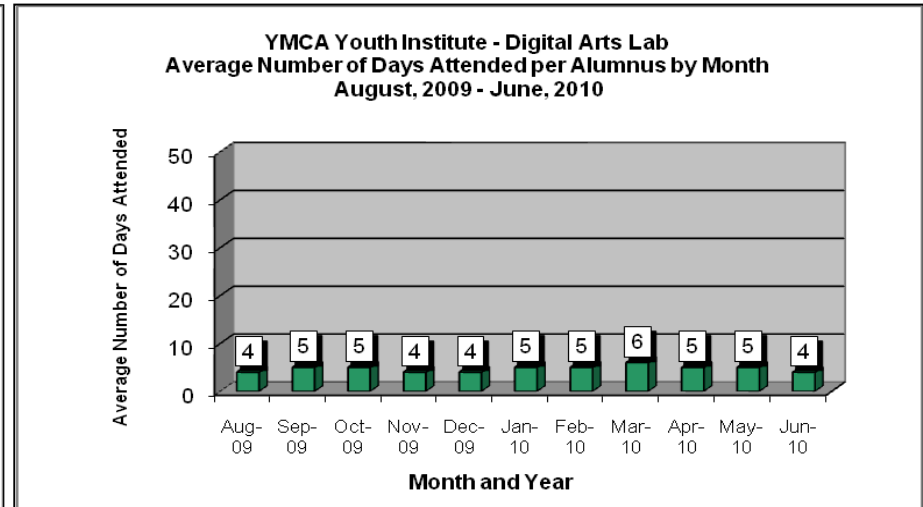
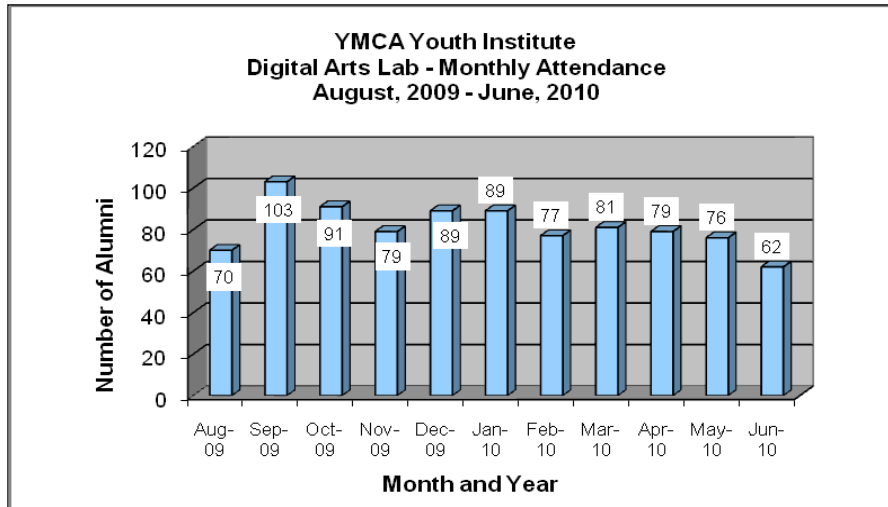


YMCA Youth Institute

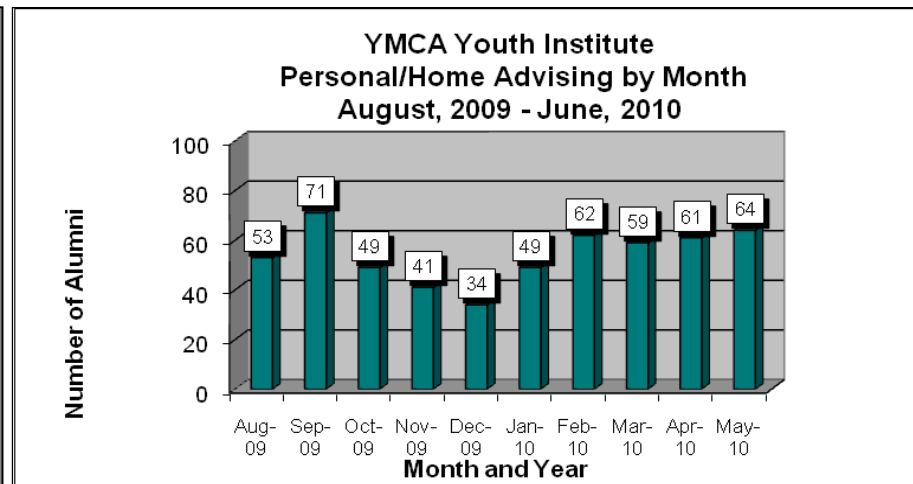
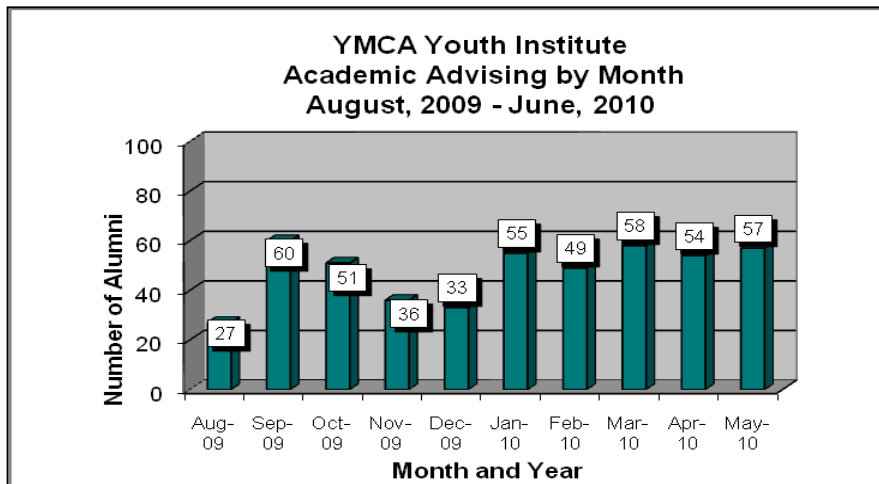


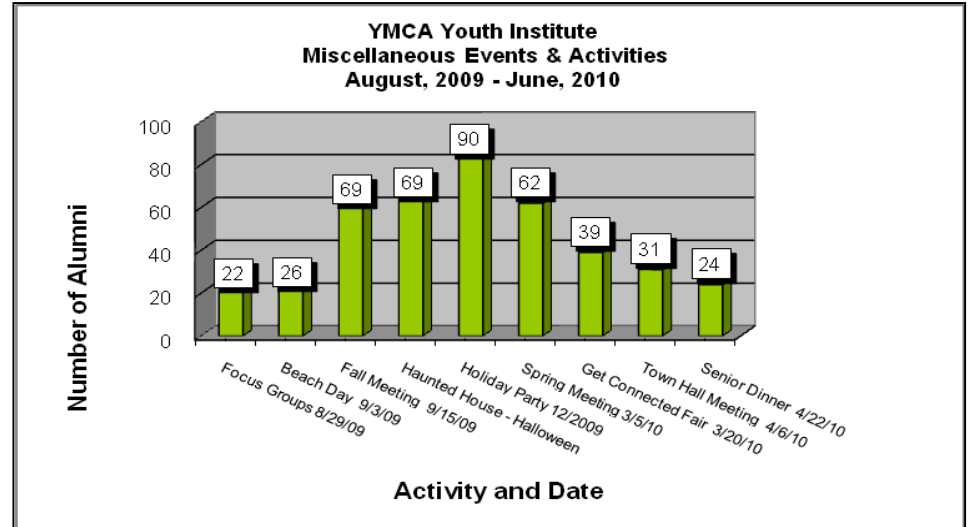
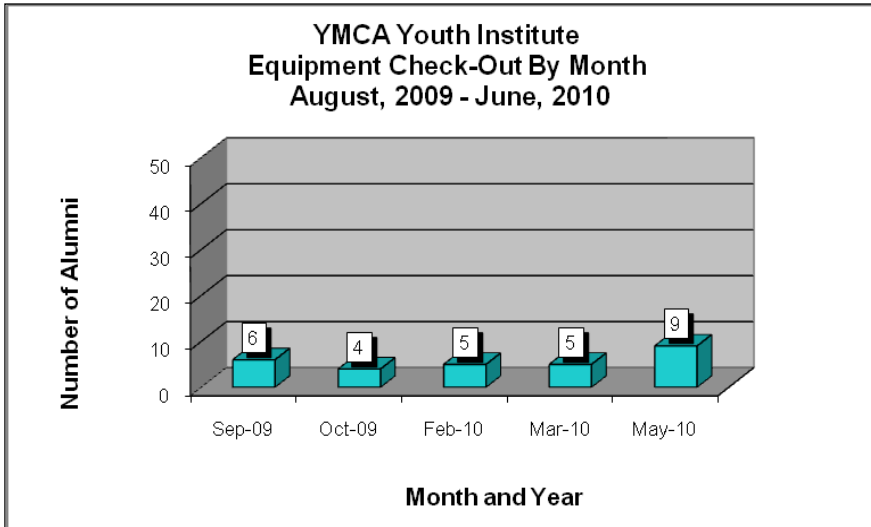
Youth Institute Alumni Attendance

August, 2009 – June, 2010

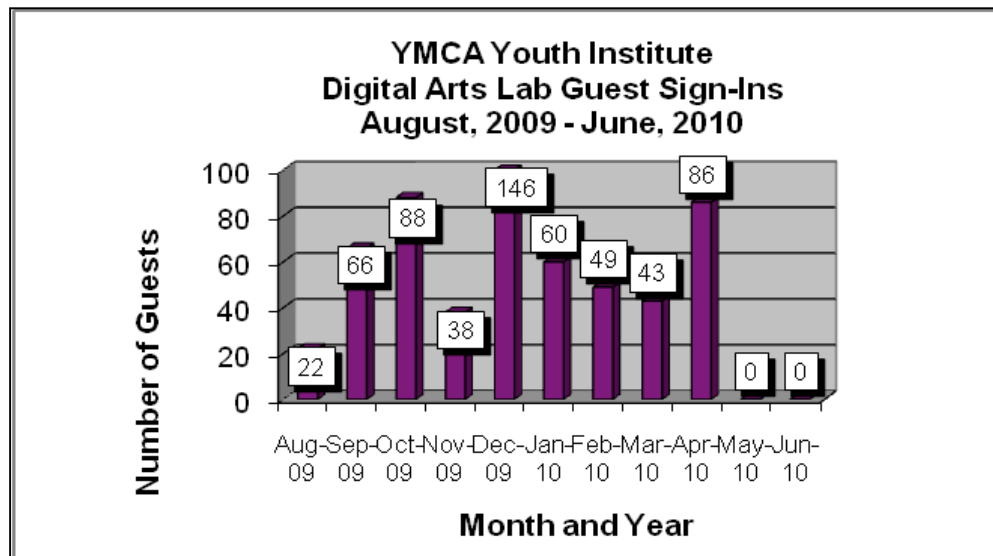


- The first graph above shows the Digital Arts Lab attendance by month. The number of alumni who attended monthly ranged from a high of 103 in September to a low of 62 in June. The overall average monthly attendance was 81 alumni.
- The second graph above shows the average number of days that each individual alumnus attended the Digital Arts Lab each month. The average number of lab visits made by each alumnus ranged from an average high of 6 days in March to an average low of 4 days in various months. The number of monthly lab visits made by individual alumnus ranged from 1 to 22 times. The overall average number of days attended by each alumnus was 5 days per month.
- Alumni often receive assistance from staff about academic issues. The first graph below shows the number of alumni who received Academic Advising by month. The highest month was September with 60 alumni. The lowest month was August with 27 alumni. The overall average monthly number of alumni who received academic advising was 48.
- Alumni often receive advice from staff about personal/home concerns. The second graph below shows the number of alumni who received personal/home advising by month. The highest month was September with 71 alumni. The lowest month was December with 34 alumni. The overall average monthly number of alumni who received personal advising was 54.

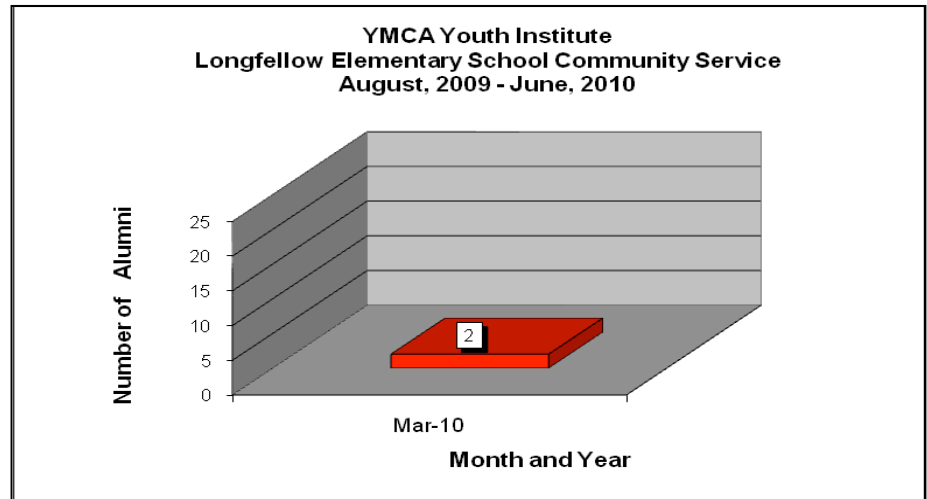
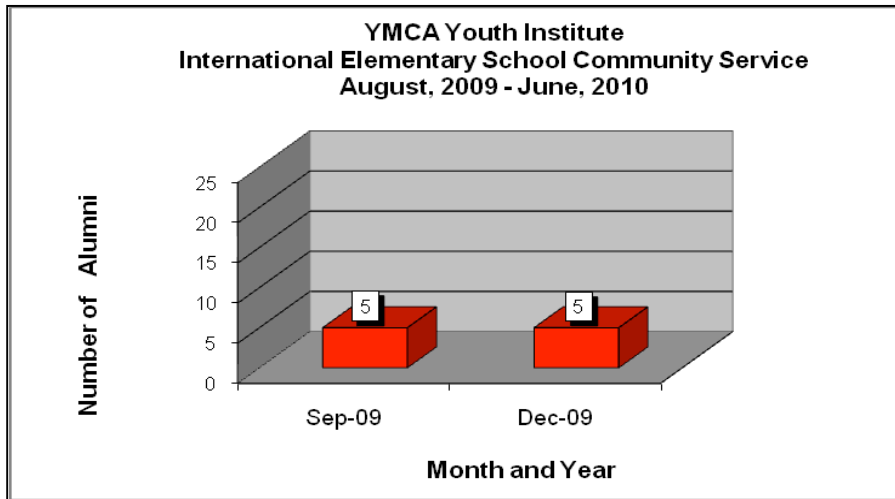




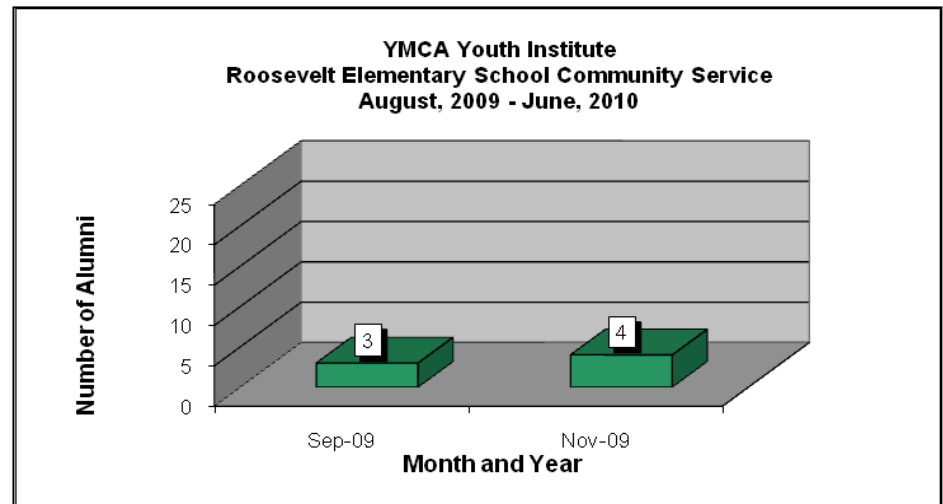
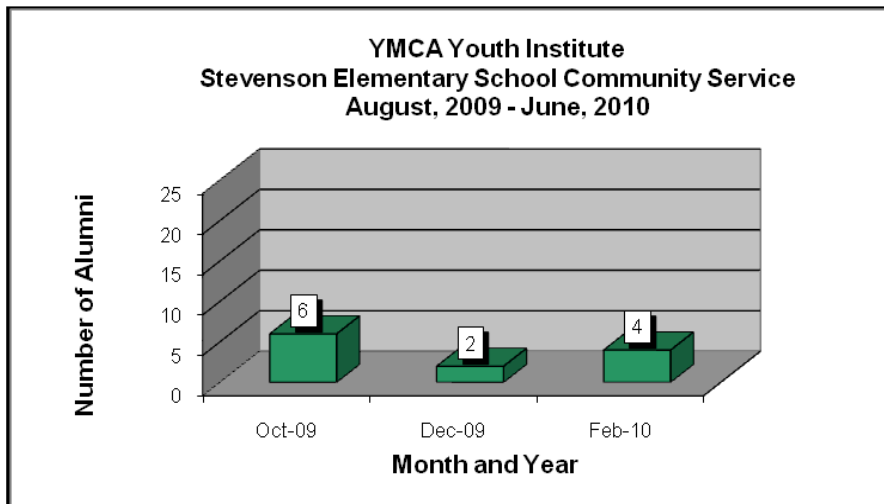
- Alumni are able to check-out equipment such as laptop computers and LCD projectors for home and school use. The first graph above shows the number of alumni who checked equipment out by month. The highest month was May with 9 alumni checking out equipment. The lowest month was October with 4 alumni checking out equipment. The overall average number of alumni who checked out equipment per month was 6. The overall average number of equipment pieces checked out per alumnus was 1 per month.
- The second graph above shows the nine miscellaneous activities during this time period. The focus group meeting was attended by 22 alumni, beach day by 26 alumni, fall meeting by 69 alumni, haunted house by 69 alumni, holiday party by 90 people, spring meeting by 62 alumni, get connected fair by 39 alumni, town hall meeting by 31 alumni, and senior dinner by 24 alumni.
- Youth Institute alumni are also encouraged to bring visitors/friends to the Digital Arts Lab. The first graph below shows that December had the most guest sign-ins with 146, and May and June had the least with 0. The overall average monthly attendance was 54 guests.

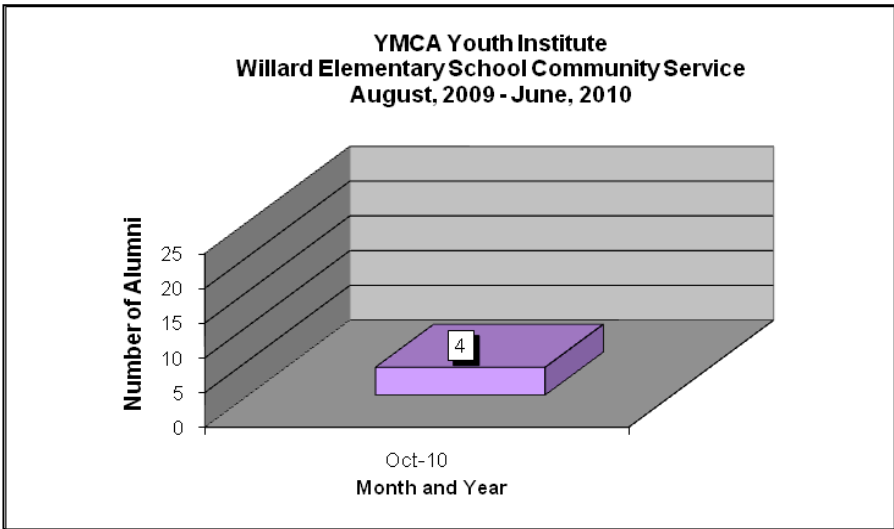
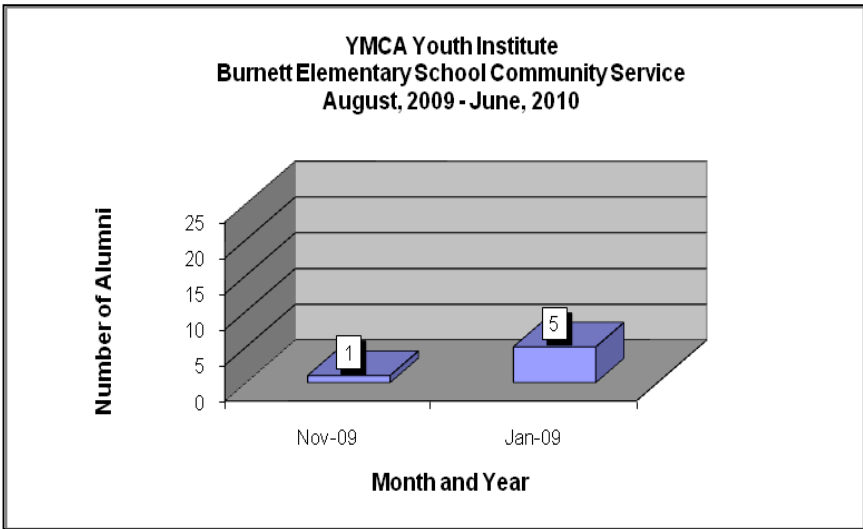


Community Service Activities
August, 2009 – June, 2010

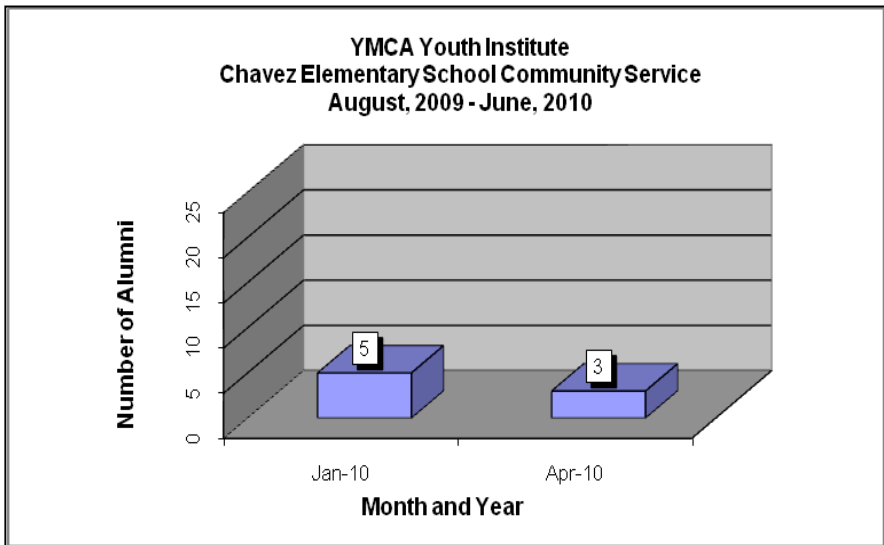


- YI alumni are also able to participate in community service projects. The first graph above shows International Elementary School Community Service alumni attendance. The average monthly attendance was 5. The overall average number of alumni who attended monthly was 5.
- The second graph above shows Longfellow Elementary School Community Service alumni attendance. The average monthly participation was 2.
- The first graph below shows Stevenson Elementary School Community Service alumni attendance. The average monthly attendance ranged from a high of 6 to a low of 2. The overall average number of alumni who attended monthly was 4.
- The second graph below shows Roosevelt Elementary School Community Service alumni attendance. The average monthly attendance was 3.





- The first graph above shows Burnett Elementary School Community Service alumni attendance. The overall average number of alumni who attended was 3.
- The second graph above shows Willard Elementary School Community Service alumni attendance. The overall average number of alumni who attended was 4.
- The graph below shows Whittier Elementary School Community Service alumni attendance. The overall average number of alumni who attended was 1.



Conclusions

- In comparison with the same time frame last year (August, 2007 through May, 2008), the average monthly attendance in the Digital Arts Lab increased from 76 to 81 alumni. This represents a 6% increase in average monthly attendance. The average number of days attended per alumnus averaged 5 days per month.
- The average number of alumni who received academic advisement increased from an average monthly number of 36 to 48 alumni. This represents a 25% increase over last year.
- The average number of alumni who received personal/home advisement increased from an average monthly number of 50 to 54 alumni. This represents a 7% increase over the last year.
- Looking at the guest sign-ins compared to the same time frame last year, the average number of monthly guest sign-ins at the Digital Arts Lab decreased from 73 to 58 guests. This represents a 20% decrease from last year.
- The average number of equipment checkouts per month decreased from an average monthly of 9 to 6 pieces. This represents a 33% decrease in the number of alumni who checked out equipment per month.
- The average attendance for the Haunted House could not be compared this year since there was only an overall sign-in sheet, instead of daily sign-in sheets. This year, the Haunted House had 69 alumni in attendance.
- + • While it is somewhat of a challenge to precisely compare the community service activities at the different elementary school sites, overall, the number of sites remained the same this year at 7, however, the number of monthly activities at those 7 sites decreased by 19% (from 16 last year to 13 this year).
